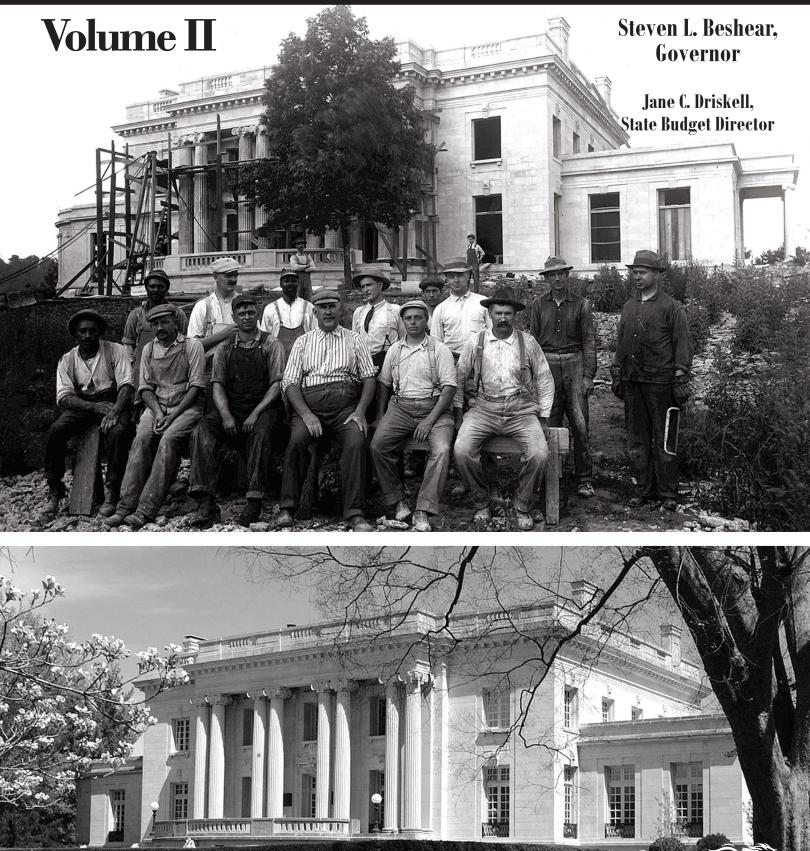

The Economic Development Bond program makes grants and forgivable loans through local government units to companies that locate or expand a manufacturing, distribution, service or technology operation in the Commonwealth. Recipient firms must commit to creating new jobs or maintaining existing jobs employing Kentuckians.

The High-Tech Construction/Investment Pool supports the growth of innovation-based business and industry in Kentucky. Pool loans and grants target New Economy niche areas where Kentucky can gain a competitive edge in the emerging 21st Century economy, supporting a strong research and development infrastructure, training a high-tech workforce and increasing access to capital for high potential technology firms. Notwithstanding KRS 12.278(4), the secretary of the Cabinet for Economic Development may use funds appropriated to the High-Tech Construction/Investment Pool for economic development bond projects pursuant to KRS 154-12.100.

This project will construct a 155,000 square foot interdisciplinary classroom building. The new building will provide office space for the departments in the College of Arts and Sciences along with high-technology classrooms and student laboratories to facilitate instruction for both undergraduate and graduate students.
