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GENERAL FUND AND ROAD FUND RECEIPTS FOR NOVEMBER 2011

General Fund receipts declined 2.8 percent Road Fund receipts rose 5.7 percent

FRANKFORT, Ky. - State Budget Director Mary Lassiter reported today that General Fund receipts declined 2.8 percent in November compared to last year. Total revenues for the month were \$728.7 million, compared to \$749.5 million during November 2010. Receipts have now risen 2.1 percent for the first five months of the fiscal year, and would need to increase 0.7 percent over the final seven months of FY12 to achieve the official revenue estimate of \$8,871.2 million.

Road Fund receipts for November totaled \$123.5 million, a 5.7 percent increase from November 2010 levels. Year-to-date Road Fund receipts have grown 6.4 percent. Based on collections through the first five months, Road Fund receipts can decline 4.3 percent over the balance of the fiscal year to meet the official FY12 estimate of \$1,340.9 million.

Lassiter noted that even though revenue collections dipped in November, the underlying economic conditions have improved since the budget was enacted, and receipts are in line with recent preliminary revenue forecasts. "The Consensus Forecasting Group projected \$137.7 million of excess revenues in October for this fiscal year. Revenue growth to date is generally consistent with that outlook. The CFG will meet later this month to finalize the revenue estimates."

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Among the major accounts,

- Corporation income tax receipts rose \$2.3 million in November and are up 12.6 percent year-to-date.
- Individual income tax collections fell 5.5 percent due primarily due to negative balances on net returns but are up 2.8 percent for the first five months of FY12.
- Sales and use tax receipts were up 2.6 percent in November and stand 4.9 percent above levels seen during the same period in FY11.
- Property tax collections fell 5.9 percent and are down 16.3 percent year-to-date. Timing issues continue to affect property tax collections.
- Cigarette tax receipts rose 5.1 percent in November but are down 5.5 percent for the first five months of the fiscal year.
- Coal severance tax receipts rose 2.6 percent and are up 11.3 percent year-to-date.
- Lottery revenues grew 2.9 percent for the month and are up 4.5 percent for the year.

Road Fund receipts rose 5.7 percent in November as motor fuels tax collections continued to increase. The growth rate of motor fuels tax collections has increased in four of the first five months of FY12, climbing from 3.8 percent in October to 7.0 percent in November. Motor vehicle usage tax receipts dipped nearly 15 percent in November, but is not a major cause of concern as October reflected a 33.1 percent increase, indicating timing issues are likely the cause of the swing in receipts. License and privilege tax receipts grew 33.4 percent on the strength of weight distance and motor vehicle license collections. Year-to-date collections for this account are up 11.9 percent.

Lassiter noted that November receipts for the Road Fund are ahead of the official estimates but consistent with the preliminary CFG estimates issues in October, which projected \$72.2 million in excess revenues for the current fiscal year.
